Notes:

- 1) Only points earned during the period of October 15th (of preceding year) to October 14th, (of current year) are counted towards the current Club of the Year (COTY) Award.
- 2) 5 Star Club Status requires a minimum of 250 points.
- 3) The Opening Day on the Bay COTY rules are to encourage Non-Bay Area Club participation by giving them the opportunity to build relationships between clubs, increase the number of boats in parade, and accrue COTY points. Bay Area Yacht clubs are defined as clubs located within SF Bay bounded by the **west side** of the Carquinez Bridge and the **east side** of Golden Gate Bridge. Outlying clubs are defined as Delta, Lake, and Coastal Clubs located outside of the SF Bay Area.
 - a) If a Bay Area PICYA yacht club joins with an outlying PICYA yacht club to work together to decorate a boat(s) for the Opening Day Parade, both yacht clubs will receive COTY points for the entry.
 - b) If two yacht clubs outside of the Bay Area join together to decorate and bring **a boat for participation in Opening Day**, both yacht clubs will receive COTY points.
- 4) **Club Commodore must verify activity by sending a letter on Club stationery or email to the COTY Chair by October 14, (of current year).**
- 5) There shall be no limit on the consecutive years any Club may win the COTY contest.
- 6) Each Club is encouraged to keep its own record of points earned and to notify the COTY **Chair/Committee** of any discrepancy as soon as noticed. Club standings are published regularly at www.picya.org
- 7) Clubs wishing points for Club Newsletters with RBOC/PICYA articles should send **ONLY** a copy of the articles to the COTY Committee, not the entire newsletter. Identify the date and club on each copy. These are due by October 15 of said year.
- 8) Sub-Category Points are the maximum points that can be earned in a sub-category of the larger event.
- 9) Club Star Ratings by points are as follows:
