**Sea Ray Boat Club** – Presented two checks one for the Wheel Chair Regatta and one for Make a Wish.


**Half Moon Bay Yacht Club** — Labor Day festival is taking place again this year. There will be many activities and a wonderful dinner. Please see HMB web site.

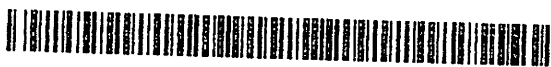
